1. Register at https://hamstudy.org This site has all of the questions that you will see on the exams and several different ways to study them. There is also a downloadable app for IOS for \$3.00.









- **3.** Study the technician questions. I prefer to use the "Study Mode"









4. Take the HAMSTUDY practice exams.





6. When you receive your FRN, you can register for the test. Go to https://hamstudy.org to find a test location and to schedule the test.






